All bids will be publicly opened and read at 3:05 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 777 Pearl Street, for the following local improvement:

Job 2758

Sanitary Sewers: In the River Road Area of Eugene, in Basin H; generally between Beltline Road and East Maynard Avenue and east of River Road (approximately 990 lin. ft. 10" PVC pipe; 14,700 lin. ft. 8" PVC pipe; 6,400 lin. ft. 6" PVC pipe; 59 manholes). This project is federally funded.

Sixty-five (65) work days will be allowed for completion of the project.
