#### Federal Fiscal Year 1992 Intended Use Plan For the State Revolving Fund

The State of Oregon's Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has prepared its Federal Fiscal Year 1992 Intended Use Plan for The State Revolving Fund in accordance with procedures set out in Division 54 of Chapter 340 of Oregon Administrative Rules. Public comments are requested during the next thirty (30) days. After review of the comments and incorporation of all appropriate changes, the DEQ intends to submit the Intended Use Plan to the Region 10 Office of the Environmental Protection Agency for review and approval.

If approved in its current form, the Intended Use Plan would use \$21,949,191 in federal grant funds and \$4,389,838 in state funds to pay program administrative costs and to provide twenty-one low interest loans totaling \$25,471,061 to twenty-one municipal corporations for the planning, design and construction of wastewater treatment works needed to correct priority water quality problems.
