### Blacks in Poll Back Tyson

Mike Tyson was given a six-year prison sentence for the rape of Desiree Washington, but a new nationwide radio polling service used to gauge public opinion among Blacks shows that a majority does not agree that the former boxing champion should go to jail as a result of his rape conviction.

Of those responding to the question: "Should Mike Tyson go to Jail?" 58% answered no. Forty-two percent responded yes to the question.

The Buy Freedom 900 Opinion Poll is conducted by Black-oriented radio stations nationwide. Callers can vote on issues of current interest via a touch-tone phone 24 hours a day 7 days a week by calling 1-900-976-5558. A flat charge of 99 cents is placed on the caller's monthly phone bill for the service.

This week's question is: "Will you vote for politicians who wrote a bad check?"

Callers to 1-900-976-5558 who vote in the weekly opinion poll and place the 99 cent charge on their phone bill will also get a toll-free 800 number they can call for information on getting a free copy of Tony Brown's Journal magazine with its annual Black History quiz and a video catalog with over 200 titles.

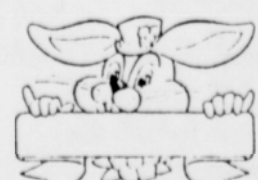
