The 34th Annual Ebony Fashion Fair will appear in Portland at the Masonic Temple, 1119 S.W. Park Avenue, on Friday, April 24, at 8:00 p.m. This famed traveling fashion show is produced by Ebony Magazine and is sponsored by the Portland Chapter of LINKS, Incorporated, for the benefit of Links' Education and Scholarship fund.

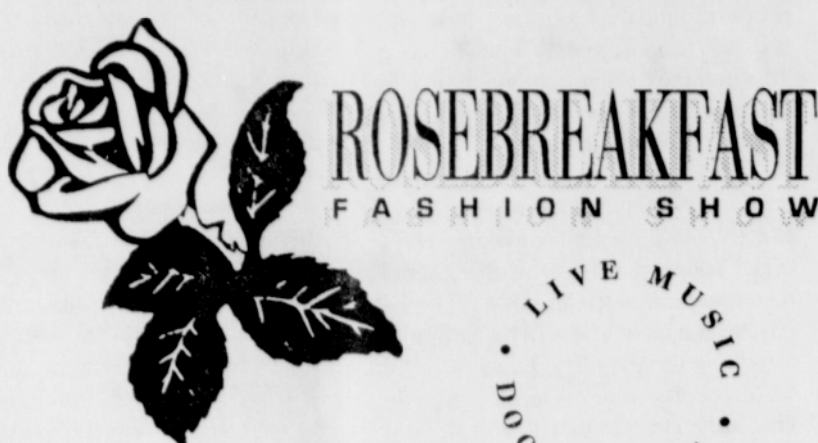
