On September 30, 1990 Bro. Coleman became the Evangelist of the Diane Avenue Church of Christ in the City of Pittsburg, CA. There under his direction the following programs have been set up: a Substance Abuse Program, Literacy Program, Child Abuse Awareness Program, and a local network television program entitled "Righteousness Exalts a Nation." This program is aired weekly and can be viewed in Pittsburg, West Pittsburg, and Antioch, California.

Charles Coleman was born December 4, 1955 in Oakland, CA to Melrose and Ernestine Coleman. Charles completed 14 years of his education in Oakland, which included McOlymonds High School and Merritt College.

Bro. Coleman was added to the body of Christ in 1976, under the teaching of Evangelist Joe O. Pitts, Sr. serving the 13th Avenue Church of Christ in Oakland, CA. Charles' membership remained at 13th Avenue for ten years, during which time he began preaching and teaching God's word. Bro. Coleman

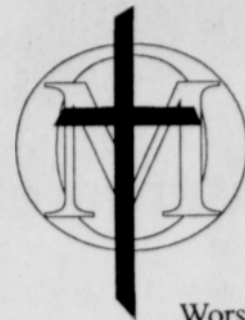

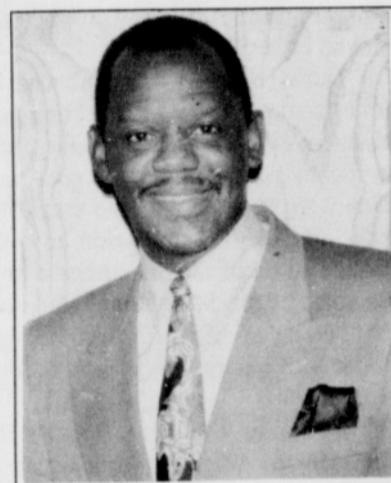

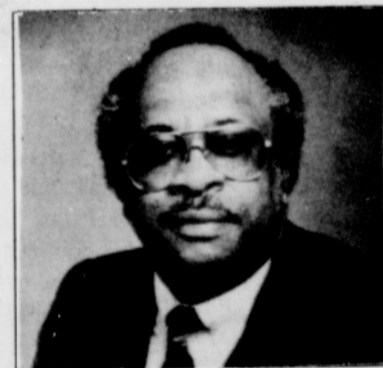
