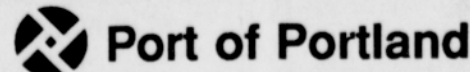

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program:

Bidders are required to show that small subcontractors, suppliers, or manufacturers which have been certified by the Oregon Executive Department as disadvantaged, minority, or women business enterprises (collectively "Disadvantaged Business Enterprises" or "DBEs") will participate in not less than 11.5 percent of the total dollar amount bid.

Description of Work:

Complete taxiway construction, including aggregate base course and bituminous surface course, subgrade sterilization, pavement marking, miscellaneous seeding, edge lighting, and airfield guidance signs.

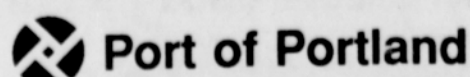
