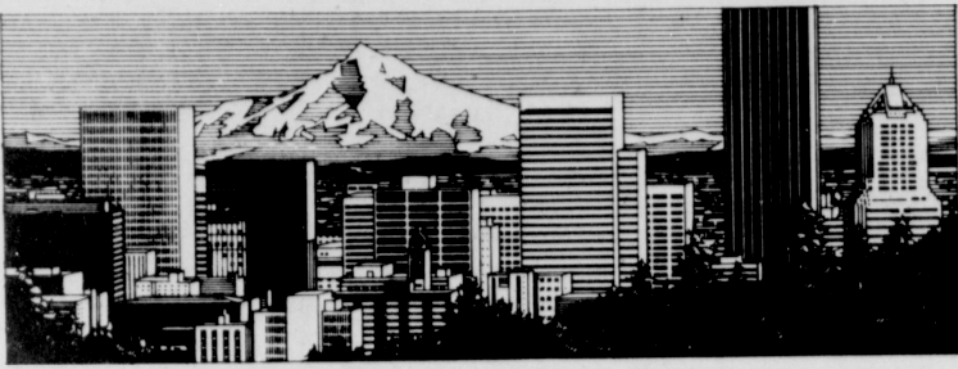

Sponsors of Large Projects are Encouraged to Apply

If you own rental property needing repairs in North, Northeast and Southeast Portland we can help. Financing may include expenses such as materials, labor, design costs, fees, title insurance and closing costs. Sponsors of projects with 20 or more units that have two or more bedrooms per unit are encouraged to apply.

For multi-family properties with five or more units, PDC offers 3% fixed rate financing for up to 25 years. Generally the available funding is for up to 50% of the rehabilitation costs.
