Johnson Creek Master Plan

The City of Gresham plans to retain consulting services to perform stormwater master planning for the Johnson Creek basin. While the resulting plan will cover only lands within the City limits, the study area will include all areas tributary to Johnson Creek and upstream from the western boundary of the city of Gresham.

The Johnson Creek Stormwater Master Plan is to be a comprehensive, technical management plan addressing both water quantity and quality issues within the basin. The project will consist of the analysis and evaluation of the existing stormwater system and the identification and recommendation of alternatives to correct deficiencies in the system and to plan for future development. Consideration of existing and proposed regulations relating to both groundwater and surface water quality will be an important element of the project. Consideration of NPDES requirements and the Part II application currently being prepared by the City's consultant will be necessary. Coordination with agencies currently involved in basinwide planning will also be required.

1. Firm Information. Firm name, address, telephone number, contact person, year established, type of services qualified to perform, and number of personnel of the firm, (if SOQ is for engineering firms include a breakdown of registered professional engineers, other degreed engineers, engineering technicians and support staff).

2. Qualifications of the Firm. A summary of projects completed by the firm which are comparable to the project description including name and location of the project, date of the project, name and telephone number of general contractor and owner representative, and name of consultant's manager on the project.

3. Qualifications of Project Personnel. The name, qualifications, specific work experience of key personnel proposed for this project. An estimate as to the percentage of time these personnel would be available during the various phases of the project shall be indicated.

These qualifications should indicate related projects worked on and include the name of the project, dates, and specific items worked on. Also, submit a list of alternative personnel available to work on the project should any of the key personnel indicated be unavailable to work on this project. Please submit qualifications and experience of alternative project personnel. Please indicate the date or dates after which proposed project team members will no longer be available to work on the project. Resumes of other important project staff may also be submitted.

Based upon the statements of qualifications, three to four of the most qualified firms will be selected to submit detailed proposals.
