**UO President To Address Eugene Downtown Lions**

What: Meeting of Eugene Downtown Lions Club featuring UO President Myles Brand as guest speaker.  
When: Noon, Wednesday, Aug. 5 (Brand's remark are expected to begin at about 12:30 p.m.)

The University of Oregon, along with the rest of Oregon higher education and other critically needed state services, continues to face dire consequences from the 1990 Oregon property-tax initiative, Measure 5.

If no solution is found to the current state government revenue crisis, the university-Lane County's largest employer-will experience higher tuition, lower student enrollment, staff layoffs and deep cuts in administrative and support services in the 1993-95 biennium due to a 20-percent cut in state funds. For the local economy, this downsizing will have a more than \$50 million impact, UO officials estimate.

This Wednesday (Aug. 5), UO President Myles Brand will provide an update on implications of the current state budget crisis for the university and his thoughts on possible developments in the months ahead as state political leaders continue to grapple with tax reform.

The event, hosted by the Downtown Eugene Lions Club, is open to the public free of charge. A buffet lunch can be purchased for \$6 (no advance reservations necessary).
