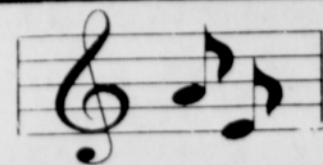

Wynton Marsalis Warns Fellow Blacks Not To Elevate Hoodlums To Heroes *Musician Reveals He Has Been Hassled By Police*

Discussing the devastating Los Angeles riots that followed the Rodney King Trial, 30-year-old jazz trumpeter Wynton Marsalis warned fellow black Americans not to elevate rioters to heroes.

In an interview to be published this Sunday in Parade, Marsalis, who says

he knows personally what it's like to be hassled by police officers, asserted, "The greatest menace in the black community is not the police. It's all these young black men who beat up old ladies and kids."

"Whenever you elevate hoodlums to heroes, you've got trouble. When

you look at that looting, by blacks and whites, that wasn't a protest. They wanted TV sets."

Marsalis, who'd just left L.A. when the riots occurred, said, "I've been hassled by the police. You grow up in this society as a black, you get that."

Marsalis, who recently split from his longtime companion, Candace Stanley, who has custody of their two sons, Wynton Jr., 4, and Simeon, 2, said he misses them terribly. "Man, I can't talk about it," he commented. "I have a picture of me with one of my sons. I can't even look at it. I start to cry."
