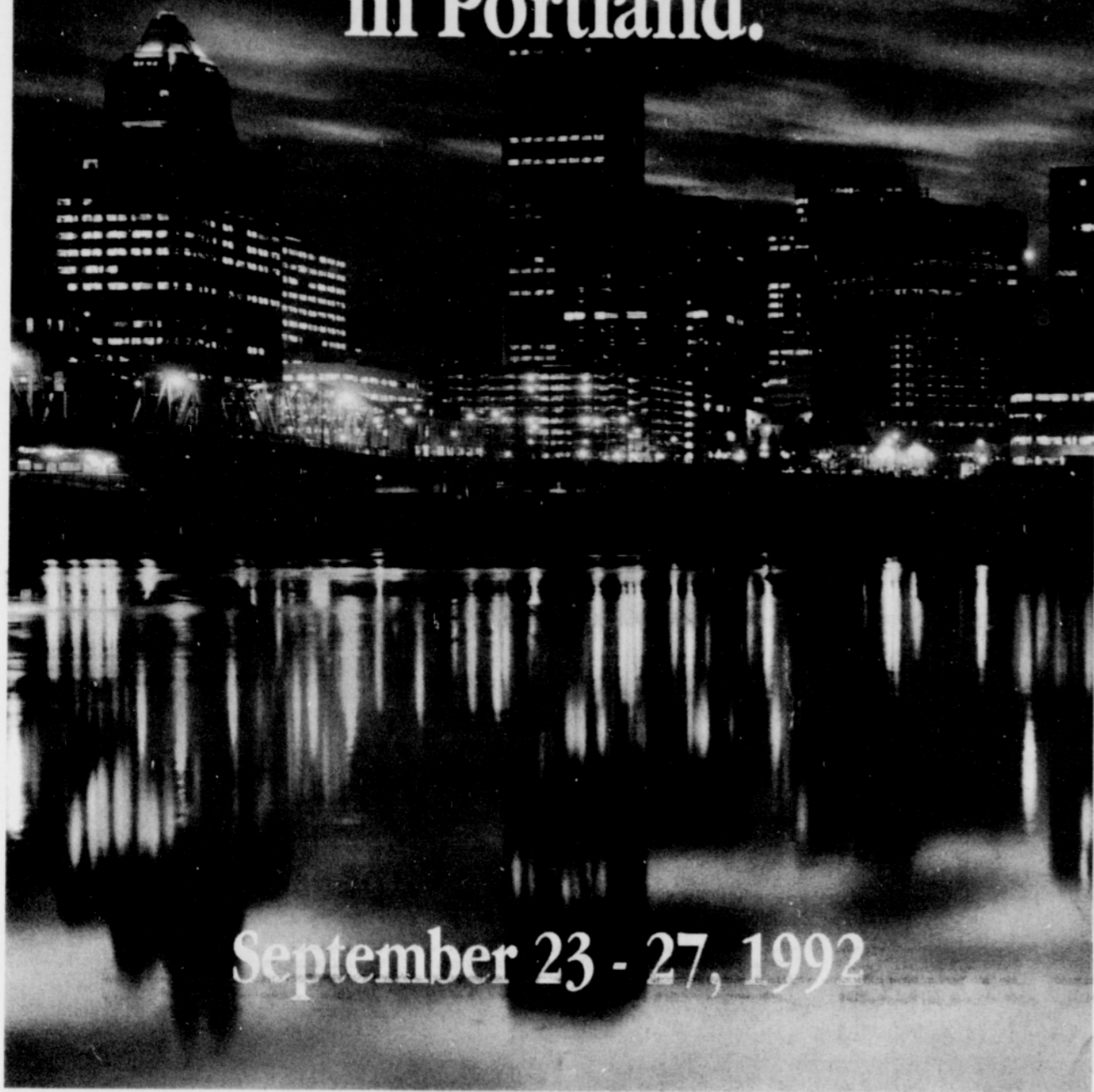

Portland Teen To Compete For Boys & Girls Clubs Of America's National Youth Of The Year Title

Julie Skidmore, age 18, a member of the Portland Boys & Girls Clubs, has been selected as one of five finalists in Boys & Girls Club of America's 1992-93 National Youth of the Year program, sponsored by Reader's Digest Association, Inc.

A recent graduate of Wilson High School, Skidmore will represent the Pacific Region at the national finals to be held in Washington, D.C., September 21-23. The National Youth of the Year will be installed by President Bush, honorary chairman of Boys & Girls Clubs of America, at a White House Ceremony on September 23.

Skidmore has been a member of the Sellwood-Moreland Boys & Girls Club, a unit of the Portland Boys & Girls Club, for two years and serves as a leader and role model for fellow Club Members. At the Club, Skidmore

served as advertising spokesperson and leader of rally workshops and calligraphy class.

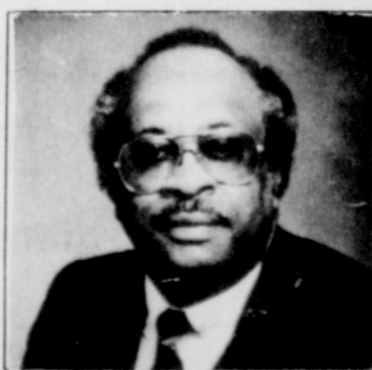
