Our new Director has the stamina and management skills that will take us into the 21st century," said Ms. Clayton.

NASCD is a Los Angeles based organization with nationwide community sickle cell programs which recently celebrated 20 years of providing education, research and patient services centering on the sickle cell conditions. Sickle cell disease is an inherited, incurable condition which primarily affects African-Americans.

Ms. Anderson has extensive experience in administration, public relations and the nonprofit sector. She has been vice president for special projects for the National Black United Fund, and public relations director for the Brotherhood Crusade in Los Angeles, CA. "I welcome the challenge to direct this organization which pioneered an effort to identify and educate the carriers of a genetic disease. We are on the brink of the 21st Century, and I want to help us get to a time when we will no longer have children born with sickle cell anemia because their parents were unaware that they carried the gene for this condition," said Ms. Anderson.


