For a year the group toured in and around the country hitting Canada, New York, Atlanta, and parts in between before heading to Jamaica where they participated in the Soul By the Sea special. The threesome toured with New Kids on the Block and were also part of the sixweek Motortown Revue, which included other Motown acts, such as The Boys, Today, M.C. Trouble and Rich Nice.

After an incredibly successful debut, which made them one of the music industry's brightest new arrivals, The Good Girls are back - effectively blending their tones with a solid mix of dance, funky midtempo and soulful ballads on their second release, Just Call Me. Their sound is bouncy, upbeat and infectiously appealing.

"We wanted to step up our singing abilities and really go all out with this new album," said Shireen. "We wanted to show how much we've developed since our first outing."
