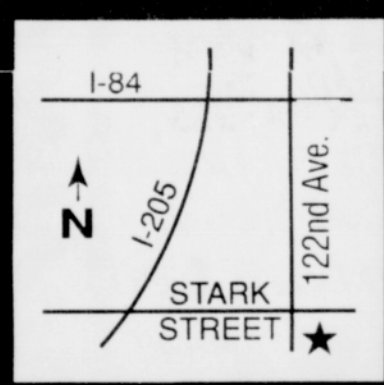

### Head Start Teachers To Receive Marylhurst Certificates Oct. 13

Twenty graduates of an innovative Head Start Summer Science Institute held this past summer at Marylhurst College will be honored in special ceremonies Tuesday, Oct. 13, at Portland's Hilton Hotel.

Marylhurst President Nancy Wilgenbusch and Ron Herndon, director of Albina Head Start, will officiate at the event, being held from 5:30 to 8 p.m. in the hotel's International Room. A reception and a buffet dinner will be held--hosted by Marylhurst trustee Bob Woodell, his wife Maryanne Woodell, and mother Myrle Woodell (philanthropist). A brief slide presentation chronicling the four-week summer institute will be presented.

Invited to the ceremonies are members of the college's Century II Steering Committee (advisory to Marylhurst's current capital funds drive), Marylhurst trustees, members of the college's Advisory council, donors to the Head Start science project and friends of the college.

U.S. West communications, which gave the college a \$30,000 challenge

grant backing the first-of-its-kind Head Start project, will be represented at Tuesday's ceremonies by Donnie Griffin, director of corporate communications and public affairs.

Barbara Brunkow, Marylhurst vice president for college relations, said also that members of the news media are welcome to attend the event. The summer institute, she noted, is the first of its kind in the nation and is seen as a possible model for other Head Start teacher-training programs throughout the country--"helping pre-school children from low-income, minority families to acquire a lifelong love of science and math."

The 20 women who attended the month-long institute at Marylhurst this summer, are currently applying the basic scientific knowledge acquired during their campus experience in their Head Start classes in the Portland metropolitan area.

Marylhurst College will present a similar institute next summer for a second group of Head Start teachers.
