Description of Work:

Drydocking; cleaning the hull; cleaning and painting screens and seachests; cleaning, inspecting repairing, and testing pumps and underwater valves; ultrasonic thickness survey; and other work that may become apparent upon drydocking. Additive alternates are: shifting Dry Dock No. 1 to a lay berth, sandblasting and painting the hull, cleaning, inspecting, repairing, and testing additional pumps and underwater valves, fleet, repairing internal coatings, cleaning silt/mud from the ballast tanks, and replacement of scupper gratings.

A prebid conference will be held on November 17, 1992, at 10:30 a.m., at the Portland Ship Repair Yard, Building 50, to discuss all phases of the work.
