Notice Of Opportunity For Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that upon request by any interested person, a public hearing will be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) at 3:30 P.M., Wednesday, December 23, 1992 at the Multnomah County Courthouse, County Commissioner's Boardroom (Rm 602), 1021 SW 4th Avenue, for the purpose of considering projects for which federal assistance under Section 9 of the Federal Transit Act as amended is being sought. Subsequent to grant approval, preliminary engineering and final environmental work on the Hillsboro Extension will proceed following the expected April 1993 selection of a Locally Preferred Alternative. The dispatch communication system project consists of two related sub-projects. The first element provides a radio data communication system and computer aided dispatch for Tri-Met's 560 fixed route and 120 demand responsive buses. The second element provides radio equipment to move communications for Tri-Met's 26 light rail vehicles (including all rail maintenance and rail transportation functions) to the 800 MHz frequency band.

No persons, families or businesses will be displaced by the projects.

Projects are in conformance with comprehensive land use and transportation planning in the area and will be programmed in the Transportation Improvement Program.

A statement of Tri-Met's charter bus service is available for inspection at the Tri-Met Administration offices.

Tri-Met will not be engaging in school bus operations.

Private transportation enterprise will not be directly affected by the projects.

At the hearing, Tri-Met will afford opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the social, economic and environmental aspects of the projects.
