Famous Flames were led to a recording contract and a song that surged to #6 on the R&B charts. Since that time, James Brown has recorded 74 R&B Top 20 hits (17 of which reached Number 1) and has sold over 50 million records. With the exception of Elvis Presley, James Brown has had more charting pop singles than any other artist in history. He's penned such inspirational and funk-filled classics as "Cold Sweat", "Say It Loud, I'm Black & I'm Proud", "Papa's Got A Brand New Bag", "I Got You (I Feel Good)" and "Sex Machine".

Holding true to his moral beliefs of mutual love and equality as success enveloped him, James Brown proved to be one of the most important black figures of the '60s and '70s. His words alone could spark social unrest and, as in the case of the 1968 Chicago race riots, his mere presence could quell racial disturbances. Even today, James Brown's word remains the universal voice of a culture. With Universal James, he continues to speak against racism, sexism and the need for improved education. In 1992, as a result of his influential steps in music and a lifetime de-

voted to equality, James Brown was honored with both the American Music Awards' Award of Merit as well as the National Academy of Arts and Science's (NARAS) Lifetime Achievement Award. Both awards honor his continuing importance through his musical and political involvement in the development of our society. With yet another groundbreaking step in music, James Brown's '90s flavored funk allows him to deliver his message of love to an ever-increasing set of followers. This new album is proof that James Brown is truly the Universal James.
