Redmond Mother Wins \$2.25 Million **Megabucks Jackpot**

Regina "Gina" Rodgers says she always felt she would win the Lottery someday. The 41 year-old Redmond resident's dream became a reality when she won the \$2.25 million Megabucks jackpot in the Wednesday, March 10, drawing. When Gina arrived at Lottery headquarters this morning to redeem her winning ticket, she received the first of 20 annual payments of \$112,500. After 28 percent is withheld for federal taxes, she will receive a check for \$81,000 each year.

Gina was accompanied to Lottery headquarters by her daughters Jill, 16, and Michelle, 18; Michelle's baby daughter, Kelsee, 3-1/2 weeks; and family friends K.C. Kenny and Misti Kenny

Gina bought her \$5 Quick Pick at $Fred\,Meyer\,in\,Bend\,on\,Tuesday,\,March$ 9. She said she's been so busy that she didn't have time to check the numbers for several days. Gina began searching for a newspaper on Friday so she could compare the numbers on her ticket. "For some reason, I knew I just had to find those numbers," she told Lottery officials.
