The Power Of Prayer

Sometimes we have trouble finding God. We know He's not hiding, but it seems that we are distanced from Him. At times like that, prayer and Bible reading are helpful. But we have access to Him in another way, too. In ourselves-in our bodies, God has hidden shadows of Himself for us to see.

Just for a moment, look at the hands we are using to hold this newspaper that we are now reading. For the rest of the week think about them as we use them.
