

City, Residents To Release N.E. 14th Place Survey, Sponsor **Clean-Up Project**

City officials and neighborhood leaders held a news conference to release the results of a survey that asked residents to evaluate traffic devices designed to discourage drug activity on Northeast 14th Place.

The group gathered at Northeast 14th Place and Alberta. Speakers included City Commissioner Earl Blumenauer, North Precinct Commander Roberta Webber, and Laura Sabatino of the Northeast 14th Place Block

Following their remarks, a Bureau of Maintenance crew and other workers finished a special clean-up of Northeast 14th Place. It is now the site of a one-year pilot project that is using street closures, a speed bump, and other traffic management devices to discourage auto traffic associated with drug activity.
