Financial Services Association Hosts Membership Reception

Minority professionals in the financial services industry are invited to attend a reception to learn about the Oregon Association of Urban Bankers (OAUB). The reception will be held on Thursday, April 22, from 6-8 p.m., at the Brooks Building, 3620 NE Williams Avenue.

OAUB is an association of minority professionals in the financial services industry, established to provide a forum to exchange ideas, experiences and interest which promote career and professional development. "If you are employed in banking, accounting, financial management, insurance, real estate, brokerage and securities, and other finance-related fields, then OAUB is for you," said Stanley Sykes, co-chair of the Membership Drive committee and a branch services officer for First Interstate Bank. "OAUB is an excellent way to meet and network with others in the same field." Roy James, branch manager for Bank of America Eastport Plaza branch, is also co-chair of the committee.

The Portland chapter of OAUB was formed in 1990. "Our mission is to provide opportunities which foster and promote the career and professional development of our membership," said Benita Harris, chapter president and a vice president in Cash Management for First Interstate Bank. "There are over 35 members, representing companies such as American State Bank, Bank of America, State Farm Insurance, Key Bank, U.S. Bank and First Interstate Bank."

OAUB has conducted numerous activities in the community since its inception. The chapter hosted its second annual awards banquet in September and awarded \$1,500 scholarship to a graduate of the Jefferson Financial Academy. In February of this year, OAUB developed a workshop targeted to young minority adults on career opportunities in banking and how to get and manage credit. Other events include the Youth Development Program (YDP) for 5th graders at King Elementary School. YDP is a program of a monthly presentations on various professions and careers, conducted by African-American role models. In addition, the students receive informed about bank products and services and maintain individual savings accounts during the school year.

OAUB is an affiliate of the National Association of Urban Bankers (NAUB). NAUB, established in 1974 and headquartered in Washington, D.C., represents over 2,000 minority professionals in 40 chapters throughout the United States.
