



If, as the father, you want to claim paternity, you can avoid going to court altogether by signing, with the mother, a sworn statement naming you as the father. To get a Declaration of Pater-Men named in paternity suits have nity (Form VS 21), simply call the Health Division (229-5895 in the Portland area, or 1-800-238-5355 for the rest of the state).
