

Los Angeles Educator Reveta Franklin Bowers Elected To Walt Disney Board Of Directors



Reveta Franklin Bowers, a Los Angeles educator, was elected to the board of directors of The Walt Disney Company.

Mrs. Bowers, 44, will fill the vacancy created by the death last February of Sharon Disney Lund, Walt Disney's daughter.

Mrs. Bowers' term runs until the annual stockholders meeting in 1996. A career educator, Mrs. Bowers has been head of school at the Center for Early Education in Los Angeles since 1976. The center has an enrollment of 475 students, from pre-schoolers through sixth grade. She holds a B.A. degree in humanities from the University of Southern California and an M.A. in development psychology from the College for Developmental Studies.

Mrs. Bowers started her educational career as a kindergarten teacher at the Little Citizens School in Los Angeles and later taught in Los Angeles Unified School District and at the

College for Developmental Studies. She serves on the boards of directors of numerous educational organizations, including the Educational Records Bureau and the National Association of Independent Schools, and has served as an officer of several professional associations.

"We are extremely pleased to have Mrs. Bowers join us on our board," said Michael D. Eisner, Disney chairman and chief executive officer, "I have had the opportunity to observe her guide the growth of a fine educational facility. Her understanding of young people and the educational process will be extremely helpful. We are fortunate to have the benefit of her experience and knowledge."

Mrs. Bowers is married to Bob S. Bowers, Jr., a municipal court commissioner. They have two children, Craig, 18, a freshman at the University of California at Berkeley, and Collette, 16, a high school junior at Harvard-Westlake School.

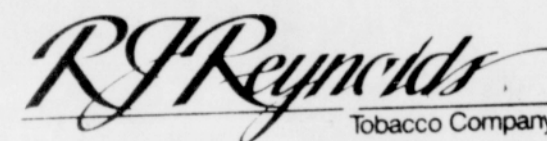
