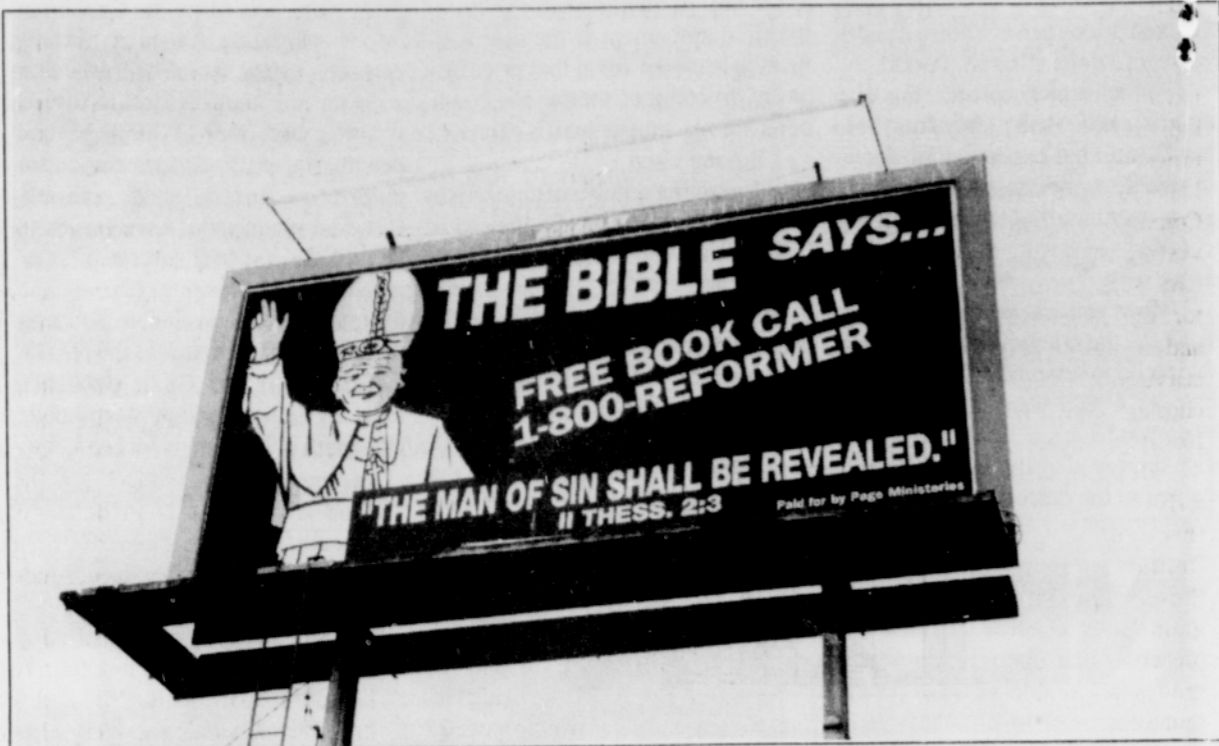

## Anti-Catholic Billboards Are A Continuing Concern For Ecumenical Ministries Of Oregon



Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon has asked Ackerley Communications to remove the billboards in the Portland area that attack the Roman Catholic Church. These billboards portray the Roman Catholic Church as part of a world-wide conspiracy of evil, using the "Anti-Christ" symbol, "666".

The billboards first appeared in the Medford area in April and were authorized and paid for by the Seventh Day Adventist (SDA) Remnant Ministries to create a climate of hatred and prejudice. They have now been put up in the Portland area in five locations.

The Rev. Dr. Rodney Page, Executive Director of Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon, stated: "We are shocked and outraged that these attacks are continuing against our broth-

ers and sisters in the Roman Catholic Church. It is sad that in this age of ecumenism, when the churches are working together as never before to work against poverty, racism and prejudice, that group spews forth its hatred and venom. The 17 denominations that constitute Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon condemn this unwarranted attack against that Roman Catholic Church and call upon the Seventh Day Adventist Remnant Ministries to take down the billboards and apologize to the Roman Catholic Church."

Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon joins with member churches in the Medford area who are saddened by this incident. As The Rev. William Creevey, Pastor of the First Presbyterian Church and President of Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon, stated,

"I am deeply saddened that this fringe group of a respected Christian body is sowing such seeds of hatred and bigotry. It is not only unwarranted and deeply regretted but also is an assault on us all."

Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon understands that the SDA Remnant Ministries is not financed by, endorsed by, or sponsored by the Oregon Conference.

Ecumenical Ministries is asking that Pastors throughout the state keep watch for SDA Remnant Ministries billboards in their area and to both complain to the billboard company when they are erected and to report them to Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon.

## Coupons Help Sick Kids

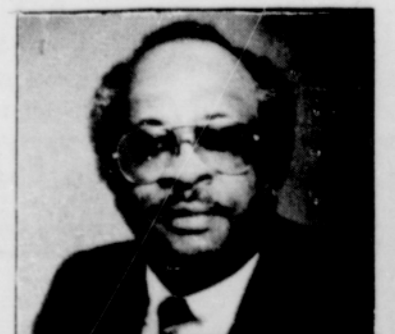
