## **Invitation To Prequalify** For Bidding

The Oregon Department of Transportation hereby solicits interest from both general contractors and subcontractors who want to perform one or more quality-critical items of work on the Depoe Bay Bridge Rehabilitation and Corrosion Protection Project. This \$2.5-\$5 million project is to be bid August 26, 1993. It is part of the Oregon's \$100 million concrete Coastal Bridge Rehabilitation and Cathodic Protection Program which extends over the next 10 years.
