### Narada Artists Tingstad And Rumbel To Visit Music Millennium

Taking New Age music beyond its traditional minimalist boundaries, Eric Tingstad and Nancy Rumbel have described their musical style as "contemporary chamber music". The duo will visit Music Millennium's eastside store at 3158 E. Burnside at 5pm on Thursday, July 1st.

The pair has a history of allowing its strong environmental convictions to shine through in its music—the 1987 album "Woodlands" was conceived as an ode to the beauty and fragility of our forests. 1991's "In The Garden" was dedicated to the practice of responsible land stewardship and the art of gardening. They have played benefit concerts for ancient forests and wetlands, and also appear annually in a series of National Park performances.

With "Give And Take, Tingstad And Rumbel's" music takes on a somewhat more eclectic flavor, combining jazz, reggae and flamenco influences in a series of songs inspired by nature. We encourage everyone to take this opportunity to meet guitarist/mandolin player Eric Tingstad and virtuoso oboe/English horn player Nancy Rumbel as they visit Portland on the occasion of their concert July 1st. ### "Music By Blue lake" Season Opener Debuts Jazz Fusion

Composer and recording artist Dale Van Wormer and his jazz fusion band open the 1993 "Music By Blue Lake" Summer concert Series on June 24, 1993 at Blue Lake Park. The concert begins at 6:30pm.

Van Wormer is a talented and well-known regional guitarist whose music style ranges from light instrumental ballads to rigorous Latin-tinged jazz fusion. Van Wormer's trademark is his dynamic sharp-guitar style, a technique he created and perfected. Van Wormer released his long-

awaited first CD "So Good" in April, 1993 to excellent reviews. "So Good" features an eclectic and intricate blend of jazz fusion ranging from flowing ballads with gentle guitar phrasings, to uptempo rhythms infused with third-world flavor.

The Van Wormer Band includes an impressive list of seasoned musicians who've played with legendary greats such as Oscar Peterson, Santana, Al Jarreau, The Beach Boys, and Diane Schur. The

Van Wormer Band features Randy Porter on piano, Graham Lear on drums, Sandin Wilson on bass, Bobby Torrez on percussion, and Patrick Lamb on saxophone.

The Thursday evening "Music by Blue Lake" concert series is sponsored by Lite 95.5 FM and Multnomah County Parks. All concerts are held rain or shine. Admission is just \$5 per car.
