TRI-MET SUPPORTS MINORITY, WOMEN AND DISLOCATED WORKER PARTICIPATION IN BUILDING WESTSIDE MAX.

When we built Eastside MAX, 22% of contract dollars went to disadvantaged business enterprise firms, well above the goals we had set. That's a record high for Oregon.

We're starting on Westside MAX, the largest public works project in Oregon history. Next year alone, we anticipate \$13 million available for certified DBE contractors.

We don't want to just meet our DBE goals on Westside MAX. We want to exceed them - by a lot. So far on the tunnel contract, more than 50% of the total subcontracted dollars have gone to very capable, accomplished DBEs.

We're looking for minority-owned businesses to prepare track right-of-way, build new transit centers and park & ride lots, and more. A list of upcoming opportunities for 1993-1994 is included below.

We want to help minority-owned businesses get certified and get work. You have to be certified as a DBE by the State of Oregon. If you want information and help in getting certified, we'll help you.

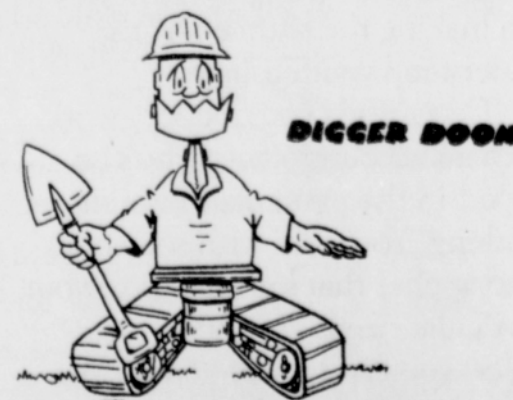
