Notice Of Cancellation Of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that the public hearing previously scheduled to be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) at 3:30 pm, December 22, 1993, at the Portland Building, 1120 SW 5th Ave., 2nd Fl., Rm. C, will not be held because no requests were received. Although no formal public testimony will be received, the Tri-Met Board of Directors meeting scheduled for this date will remain open to all citizens.

The hearing would have been held for the purpose of considering projects for which federal assistance under Sections 3 and 9 of the Federal Transit Act, as amended, are being sought. The section 3 grant application requests discretionary funding for three Banfield Light Rail Retrofit projects: Ruby Junction Expansion (\$3,975,000 federal; \$5,300,000 total budget), Double Track from Ruby Junction to Cleveland Stations (\$8,025,000 federal; \$10,700,000 total) and Communications Retrofit; \$1,408,620 federal; \$1,878,160 total budget). An additional \$1,487,591 total budget (\$1,190,073 federal share) is requested in FY94 Section 3 fixed guideway modernization formula funds for continuation of the Communications Retrofit project.

Tri-Met's proposed Program of Projects in the FY94 Section 9/ Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality application includes: Operating assistance (\$4,399,929 federal; \$8,799,858 total budget), continuation of Hillsboro Preliminary Engineering/ Final Environmental Impact Statement work program (\$871,520 federal; \$1,089,400 total budget), purchase of 19-20 standard 40-ft. lift-equipped buses for service expansion (\$3,589,000 federal; \$4,000,000 total budget), purchase of 11-12- 24-ft. minibuses for new service (\$628,075 federal; \$699,790 total budget), and design and initial construction of the Sunset Transit Center pedestrian and bike bridge (\$470,400 federal; \$588,000 total budget).
