Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program:

Bidders are required to show that small subcontractors, suppliers, or manufacturers which have been certified by the Oregon Executive Department as disadvantaged, minority, or women business enterprises (collectively "Disadvantaged Business Enterprises" or "DBEs") will participate in not less than 13 percent of the total dollar amount bid.

Description of Work:

Installation of taxiway center line lights on taxiway E, installation of wig-wag lights at entrances to runway 2-20, and installation of conduits and cables required to complete the lighting systems.

A prebid conference will be held on Wednesday, December 22, 1993, at 9 a.m. at the Portland International Airport Maintenance Facility, 7111 N.E. Alderwood Road, Portland, Oregon, to discuss all phases of this work.
