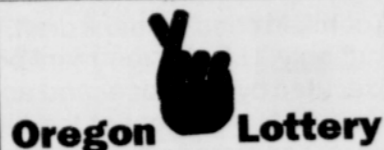

Christmas Tree recycling, A 10-year Tradition

Since 1984 metropolitan area residents have been recycling their Christmas trees through services provided by nonprofit organizations and businesses. Last year more than 63,000 trees were recycled by nonprofit groups. Trees became compost, mulch, walking paths and decorative landscape materials instead of landfill material.

"Christmas tree recycling is an easy way to continue the holiday spirit of giving," says Rena Cusma, Metro's executive officer. "Residents give their trees back to nature and support many worthwhile community projects at the same time."

Nonprofit groups and businesses will operate more than 150 drop-off sites and pickup services from Forest

Grove to Sandy and from Wilsonville to North Portland. Most groups will be collecting trees on the weekends of Jan. 1-2 and Jan. 8-9. The small fee or donation requested supports activities of groups such as the Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, churches and parent-teacher associations.

In addition to the nonprofit organizations, residents with curbside yard debris collection programs will be able to recycle their trees at the curb. The amount of preparation required and fees vary throughout the region.

fill seven seats on the committee that are about to expire, as well as fill some vacancies that have occurred. The committee's purpose is to advise the council about ways to involve the public in regional decision-making.

Item 7.6: Resolution that would authorize the executive officer to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the city of Portland to study past practices in hiring minority- and women-owned contractors.

Item 7.7: Resolution to create a Pioneer Cemeteries Study Commit-

tee that will provide recommendations to the Metro Council about how best to operate these newly-acquired historical cemeteries. Metro acquired 14 pioneer cemeteries in the recent transfer of Multnomah County's parks system. This committee will spend six months studying and establishing a system to operate and manage these cemeteries. The committee's primary study area will be to determine whether there are alternatives to public management of the facilities.
