In a related activity, Tri-Met joined forces with the City of Portland and Oregon Department of Transportation in establishing a workforce clearinghouse to encourage hiring of minorities and women on MAX and other public projects. Projected startup for the \$200,000, one-year pilot

program is the end of March.

Workforce Center is providing interim clearinghouse services to TriMet and has already contacted
Morrison Knudsen to offer assistance
with workforce recruitment. Contract

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
