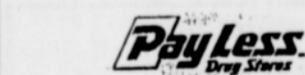

This Contract is subject to the Davis-Bacon and related Acts and no bid will be received or considered unless the Bid contains a statement by the Bidder as part of the Bid that the provisions of Davis-Bacon and related Acts (40 USC 276a) and Federal Labor Standards Provisions (HUD-4010) relating to the payment and certification of payment of wages listed under U.S. Dept. of Labor, General Wage Decision No. OR 93-1 will be complied with.
