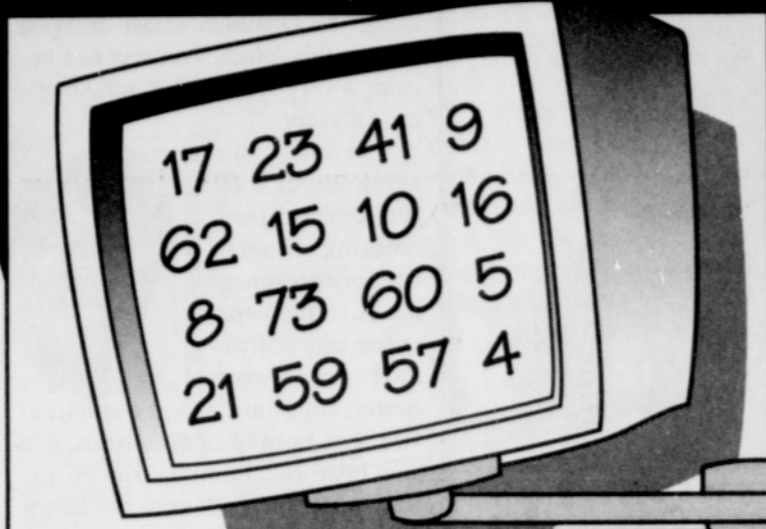

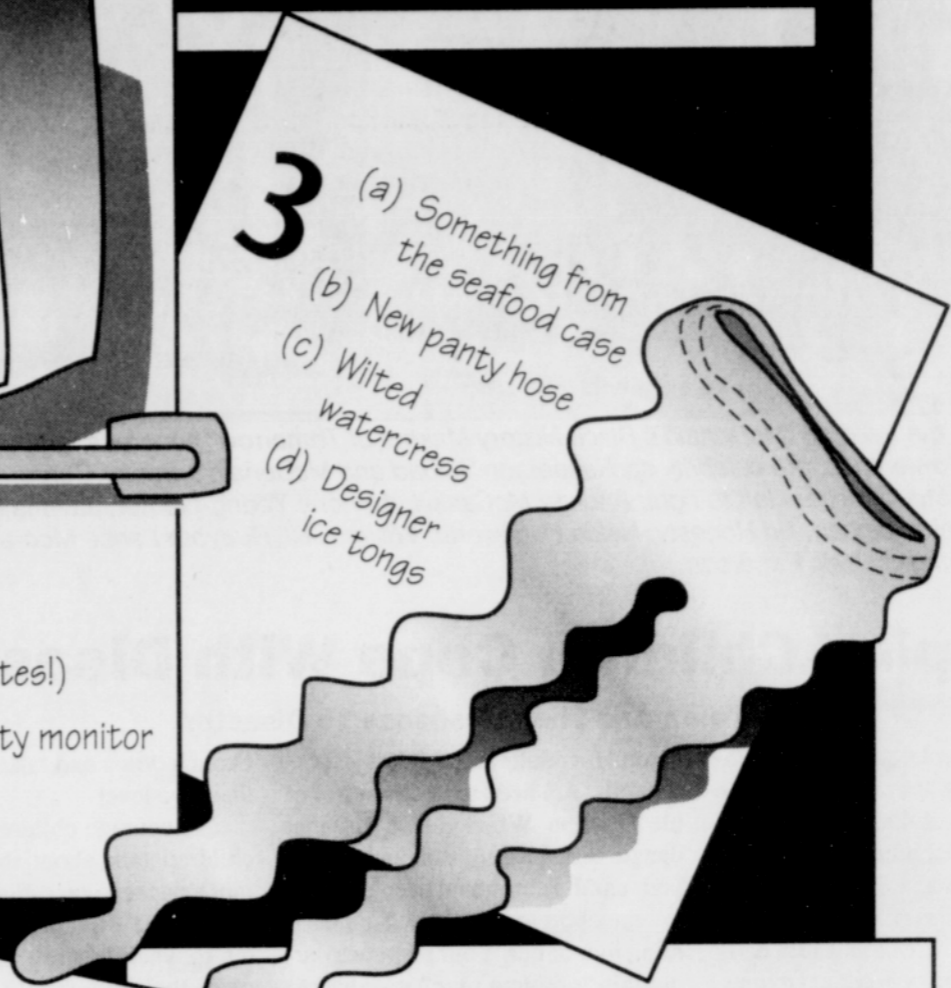

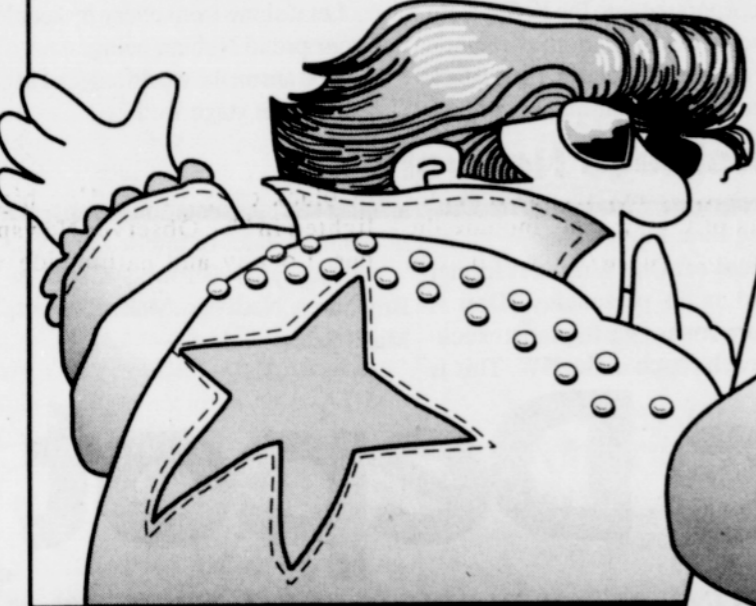

**How to play Keno** Just take this FREE KENO coupon (above) to the customer service counter or a store clerk and ask for a Keno game slip. With your Keno game slip in hand, follow these five easy steps to play:

1. Decide how many numbers (spots) you want to pick (1-10).
2. Select the dollar amount you want to play per game (\$1-\$20).
3. Pick your numbers (numbers range 1-80).
4. Mark the number of games you'd like to play (1-100).
5. Watch your game on the store's Keno monitor or come back and ask the clerk to check to see if your ticket is a winner. A new game is ready to play every 5 minutes.
