In Reno, Play An Unforgettable Round Of Golf.

With Packages That Are Truly Memorable

Imagine yourself golfing under Reno's clear blue skies with a panoramic view of the mighty Sierra Nevada mountains. Next, imagine enjoying several days in Reno while you tee off at one of the area's premier courses, at a terrific package price. But wait, it gets better. Now imagine playing the game of your life - because at this elevation, your ball flies farther.

Imagine that. Now make it real in Reno. Eleven affordable summer packages featuring Northgate Golf Club and Wildcreek Golf Course are certain to have golfers smiling not only on the links, but all the way back to their hotels as well. That's because Reno's high desert and rolling hills make for fabulous golfing. And the special packages make for fabulous savings.

Northgate Golf Club devised its landing areas with the elevation in mind. Built in the true Scottish links tradition, Northgate's natural rolling contours combine the alluring contrasts between the greens, surrounding sagebrush and a brilliant blue sky. Northgate boasts fast, undulating greens while 114 grass bunkers supplement 40 strategically placed sand traps at this championship course.

At Wildcreek Golf Course, the site of past Senior PGA Tours, golfers find sidehill, uphill, and downhill lies that make for a challenging game. The championship course, located in the foothills of northeast Reno, covers more than 7,100 yards and features a meandering stream, seven lakes and a panoramic view of Reno and the surrounding Truckee Meadows. Wildcreek also sports a par three executive course.

And - get this - courses situated at

elevations near 5,000 feet (such as those in Reno) send golf balls soaring an average 13 percent farther than balls played at a sea level course. That's right, experts have actually figured this out. But as they say, your actual mileage many vary. So take a swing in Reno and find out for yourself.

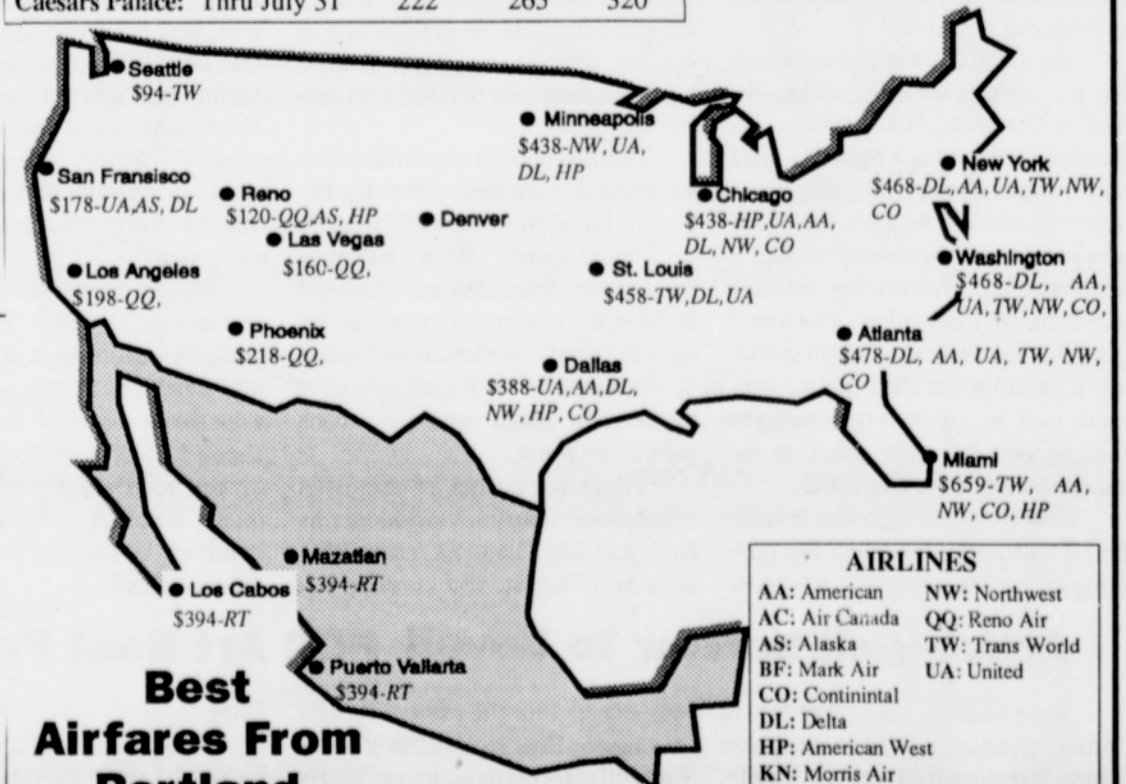
