Warner Pacific Graduate Largest Class

In keeping with the trend of the last several years, Warner Pacific College will graduate the largest class in the history of the College. Commencement ceremonies for the 155 member Class of '94 was held May 15 at 3 p.m. in the New Hope Community Church.

Dr. Ronald E. Post, president and founder of Northwest Medical Teams, delivered the commencement address titled, "Fly in Formation--Soar Above the Crow".

Baccalaureate was held in McGuire Auditorium on the campus at 7:30 p.m., May 14, Rev. Jim Reed, pastor of the First Church of God in Klamath Falls and father of Lori Fast,

a member of the graduating class, spoke on the topic, "Enjoying the Journey".

A new event was inaugurated this year in connection with graduation festivities. Taking advantage of the completion of the new Schlatter Memorial Prayer Chapel on the campus, "Commencement Communion" was hosted by the Portland Area Ministers of the Church of God from 1 to 2 p.m. on May 14. Worshipers, including graduates and their families as well as friends of the College, were invited to come and go as they wish during this service which precedes a reception to honor the graduates in the chapel's Kardatzke Hall.

According to Dr. Jean Fitzgerald, registrar, the Class of '94 includes a record 65 students completing their undergraduate work through WPC's Degree Completion program. Eight international students received degrees.

The youngest graduate was 20 years old and the oldest, 61. Business Administration awarded the highest number of degrees, 63, with the second highest number being awarded in Human Development, 45. Degrees also were awarded in Religion & Christian Ministries, Humanities, Biological Science, Sociology/Social Work and in several additional categories. Two Master of Religion degrees were awarded.

New Time Capsule

A new Time Capsule was placed in the walls of St. Paul Catholic Church, St. Paul, OR, on Tuesday May 24, 1994 at 2:00 p.m. The capsule will replace the one opened on January 6, 1994. The original capsule was found as workmen were repairing the church, which was damaged by the March 1993, Spring Break earthquake.

Among the items to be included are two issues of the Catholic Sentinel (January 7 & 14, 1994), which gave account of opening the original time capsule, 1994 Oregon Catholic Directory, a Miraculous Medal, similar to the one found in the original capsule, and other items yet to be determined. It is intended to reuse the original corner brick from 1846.

The May 24th date was chosen, because it is the 148th anniversary of the original church dedication. St. Paul church was built in 1846. The damage of the earthquake was severe, and parts of the original church needed to be taken apart, piece by piece, reinforced, and then rebuilt using as many of the original bricks as possible.

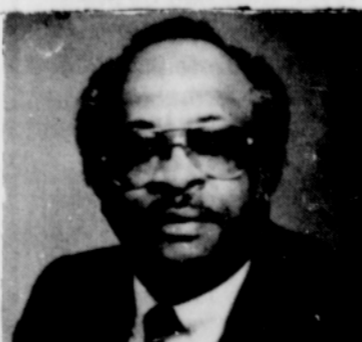
