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
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## World's Most Energy-**Efficient Refrigerator**

The most energy-efficient environmentally friendly refrigerator in the world has arrived in Portland, thanks to the support of PacifiCorp, which contributed to the funding to develop it.

Robinson said that one of the biggest incentives for the creation of a CFC-free refrigerator was the signing of the 1987 Montreal Protocol. Spurred by the growth of an ozone hole over Antarctica, the Protocol binds its 128 international members to reduce their production and consumption of CFCs by 1998, with a complete phase-out by 2000.

About the time the Montreal Protocol was signed, PacifiCorp and other organizations became frustrated with the slow pace of energy efficiency improvements in appliances. They formed the SERP consortium to pool resources and to influence the marketplace to create a refrigerator that would benefit the environment and consumers.

Members of the SERP consortium include PacifiCorp, the Bonneville Power Administration, 23 utilities, the Electric Power Research Institute, the Environmental Protection Agency, the Natural Resources Defense Council, the American Council for an Energy Efficient Economy, the Washington State Energy Office and the Department of Energy.



## **A Bright Idea On Darkness**

Being kept in the dark will at last be a pleasant and fashionable experience for Oregonians and Washingtonians, who get an average of less than 50 percent of possible sun on any given day during the year. Because sometimes real darkness is needed -- especially by babies, their parents, and anyone trying to catch a wink during daytime hours -- a new window blind called Light Garde is being introduced in the Portland and Seattle areas. The Northwest has been chosen as the first region in a national roll-out plan that will continue through 1995.


Light Garde has a revolutionary new construction that blocks light better than conventional blinds by eliminating the slat holes through which the cords are threaded. The top slat closes on the headrail to aid in light blockage and the overall design allows for tighter slat closure. Designed to reduce the amount of light allowed in the room, it is intended for childrens' rooms or nurseries, people who work at night and sleep during the day, or in any situation where almost total roomdarkening is desired. Light Garde is the first major innovation in miniblinds since the late '60s.

The new product is made by Del Mar Window Coverings of Westminster, CA. Research conducted by Del Mar indicated that a large percentage of all mini-blinds are purchased for bedroom windows. According to Joe Cole, president of Del Mar, "We realized that a stan-



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
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
