On June 20, 1994, CSD began operating from the St. Johns Branch. It houses 85 staff; some are assigned to schools in the area and to Columbia Villa. The opening of St. Johns completes the transition of caseworkers into dif-

ferent communities in the Metro area. Branches are also located in East County, Albina, and near Lloyd Center along with an office for the Child Abuse Hotline. The locations match the school districts boundaries so that St. Johns will serve the Roosevelt, Grant, Lincoln & Wilson cluster.

The welcome from businesses, schools and other groups in the area has been overwhelming," says John Barr, St. Johns Branch Manager. "From a social services standpoint, we are closer to the families we work with. From an economic angle, we revitalized a dilapidated, vacant building and added more to local business." CSD leases the building from Benenson Capital Company of New York. As part of

their mission to reuse old buildings, the company paid for the renovation and contracted with the local firms of GBD Architects, and R & H Construction.

Ranch Romance, Thara Memory To Play At Music By Blue Lake

"Retro country" and "the roots of jazz" are on tap when the Music by Blue Lake concert series features Ranch Romance on July 28 and the Thara Memory Allstars on Aug. 4. The eight-week concert series at Blue Lake Regional Park continues through Aug. 8. The two-hour outdoor concerts begin at 6:30 p.m. Admission is 5 per car. Sorry, pets are not permitted.

Since Ranch Romance first appeared on The Nashville Network in 1988, the group has captured the hearts of audiences across the nation. The five-member band consists of Jo Miller, Nancy Katz, Nova Karina Devonie and David Keenana.

Described as "retro-country," the

band corrals honkytonk, rockabilly and western swing and shoots them through a modern offbeat filter, creating a style that has been called "the freshest, most enthusiastic sound in country music today" by Tower Records' "Pulse!" magazine. The group has released three albums and has appeared on numerous radio shows including Garrison Keilor's "American Radio Company" and National Public Radio's "All Things Considered."
