In Memory Of Princy George Givens

Funeral Services for Princy George Givens of Portland were held Wednesday, July 20 at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church with Rev. C. E. Faulkner, pastor, presiding.

Givens, 82, died July 15, 1994. He was born Aug. 2, 1911 in Woodland, Texas, the sixth child of Edward and Leecy Givens. He had 12 brothers and sisters. When he was 2 years old, his family moved to Grant, Okla. and later to Luther, Okla. where he received his formal schooling.

In 1965 he moved to Yakima, Wash. where he accepted Christ and united with the Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church. In 1969, Givens and his family moved to Portland where he joined the St. Paul Baptist Church and served as a church deacon. He was employed with the Freightliner Corp. where he retired in 1976.

Emmanuel Community General Services Inc. Declared A Moratorium

Words cannot express our sorrow over the loss of the lives of Corey Graves and now Roy Jackson, Jr.

Emmanuel Community General Services is a church based, non-profit social service agency providing a myriad of services to children, youth, and families. The services provided are in education; employment; housing; daycare; entrepreneurship, training and manufacturing; youth outreach; intense follow-up; youth growth and development.

For over fifteen years, we have also provided housing for adults and youth who are not high risk.

Because of the urgent need in our community, we extended a similar service to high risk youth and adults with the intent of providing for self-determination and independent living. The majority of the costs have been provided by the Church, not government contracts.

Following the first incident, the Board of Directors reduced our gang population to only one slot. Following this last incident, we have declared a moratorium on all housing for developmentally disabled youth and high risk adults and juveniles. The moratorium will remain in effect until an independent investigation is completed which will address all of the issues in providing housing for high risk individuals.

Our community needs to provide these persons with shelter. We regret that we will no longer be able to do so, at least for now. We ask for your understanding, your guidance and your prayers as we continue this worthy humanitarian work.
