### Hoyt Apartments Site & Dwelling Improvements

Sealed bids will be received at the Housing Authority of Portland (HAP), 8910 N. Woolsey Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97203, until 2:00 p.m., Thursday, **September 1, 1994**, for labor and materials to make site and dwelling improvements at (1) existing apartment projects. Shortly thereafter, bids will be opened and publicly read. Interested parties are welcome to attend.

The basic work consists of demolition, concrete walkways and stairs, modular block retaining walls, steel handrail and guardrails, composition roofing, gutter and downspouts, subdrainage system, vinyl flooring, site lighting, and landscaping. The site is Hoyt Apartments, 6304, 6, 10, 12 NE Hoyt Portland, Oregon.

Interested bidders may obtain one set of bid documents at the HAP Maintenance Office, upon receipt of \$20 Twenty Dollar deposit, which is refundable when documents are returned in good condition within 10 days after bid opening. Additional sets may be acquired for a \$20 Twenty Dollar non-refundable fee.

A HAP representative will conduct a **pre-bid tour** of the project at 6304, NE Hoyt, at 10:00 a.m., **Thursday, August 18, 1994**, and the attendance of bidders is requested. An orientation will be given prior to moving to the project site. questions posed during the tour, when not addressed in the specifications, will be answered by addendum and mailed to all bidders.

Attention is called to the provisions in "Supplemental Instructions to Bidders" regarding MBE participation and Division "H", "Special Conditions", regarding non-discrimination of Handicapped Persons, Workers' Compensation Insurance and Pre-qualification of Contractor. Minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the specifications shall be paid on this project.

A bid security of 5% of the bid is required as prescribed in the "Instructions to Bidders" Division B.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for a satisfactory Performance and Payment Bond for 100% of the contract amount, or separate Performance and Payment Bonds, each for 50% or more, or a 20% cash escrow or 25% irrevocable Letter of Credit of the full amount of the Contract.

As permitted by State law and required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the following rules shall apply:

- Retainage is 10% (not 5%)
- Interest shall not accrue on retainage, and
- Bonds or securities may not be substituted as an alternate form of retainage.

No bidder may withdraw their bid after the hour set for opening thereof until after the lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid opening.

The Housing Authority of Portland may reject any bid not in compliance with the prescribed bidding procedures and requirements and may reject any or all bids and waive all informalities if, in the judgment of HAP, it is in the public interest to do so.
