In addition to probing the personal side of Billy Graham, Crusade: The Life Of Billy Graham goes behind the scenes of one of his crusades. Evangelicals believe that conversion, the act of accepting Jesus as your personal Lord and Savior, is a process every man, woman and child needs to go through in order to be saved. Graham's crusades are centered around bringing about those conversions. Each night, at the conclusion of his sermon, Graham invites members of the audience to come forward to the base of the stage as a public declaration of their new or renewed commitment to Jesus.

To this end each crusade, like the one in Portland, Oregon, is the culmination of years of careful planning. The scale of each event is immense, form ushers and technicians to choir members and counselors. In all, the Graham organization estimates that 30,000 people played some part in preparing for the Portland crusade. Oregon Public Broadcasting is a public television and radio network serving Oregon and southern Washington.




