

Terminal 6 Berth 603 Asphalt Resurfacing

Sealed bids for the Terminal 6, Berth 603 Asphalt Resurfacing project will be received by the Manager, Contracts and Procurement, of The Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, 15th Floor, Portland, Oregon, (503) 731-7590 (mailing address: Post Office Box 3529, Portland, Oregon 97208) until, but not after, 2 p.m. on Wednesday, August 17, 1994, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Description of Work:

Repair eleven 1050-foot long (approximately) sections of existing asphalt concrete of varying widths (eight sections 6 feet wide, one 7 feet wide, one 12 feet, 2 inches wide, and one 12 feet, 7 inches wide) all adjacent to portland cement concrete crane running strips. The repair is to be accomplished by cold planing the existing uneven surface and constructing a new asphalt concrete surface course flush with the top of the portland cement concrete crane running strips.

A prebid conference will be held at 9 a.m. on Monday, August 15, 1994, in the Terminal 6 Administration Building to discuss all phases of the work.


