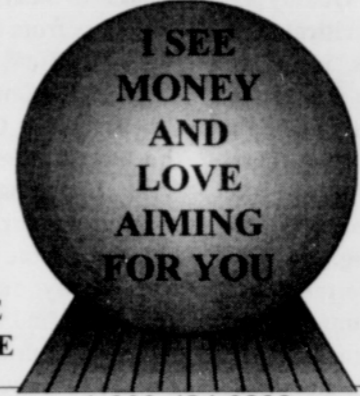

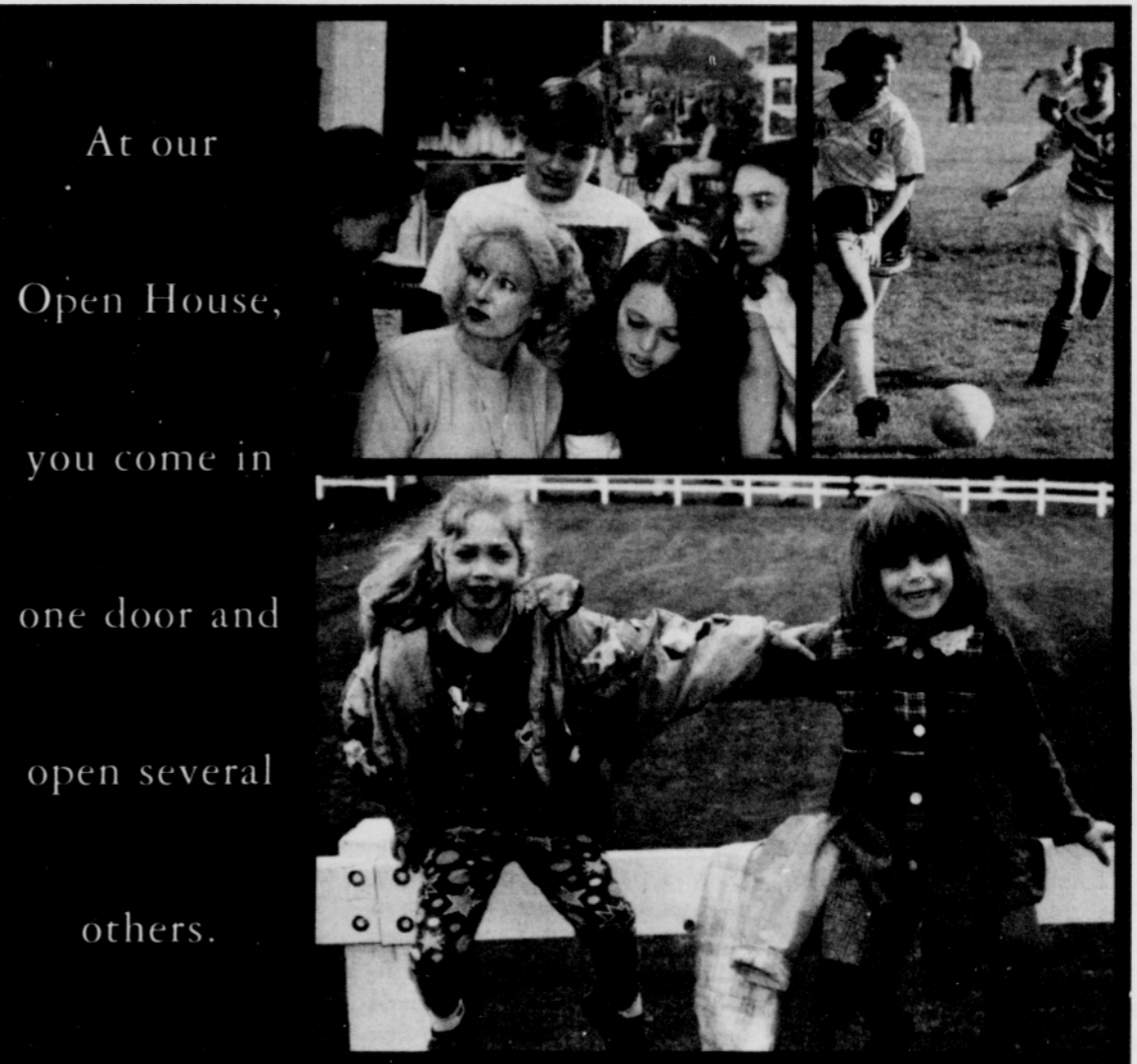

Important Notice About Construction Waste Disposal

If you dispose of mixed construction waste generated within the Metro region, it must be taken to a Metro-designated facility or transported under the authority of a Metro non-system license. Inert materials, such as concrete, rock and asphalt, and separated recyclable items taken to a recycler are not subject to this requirement.

To request a list of designated facilities and a map of the Metro boundary, call Metro, 797-1650. To use non-designated facilities, you must first obtain a non-system license. To apply, call 797-1685.

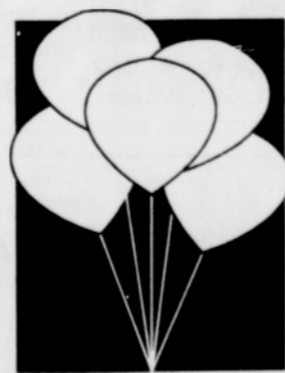
As the regional government responsible for solid waste management in the metropolitan area, Metro licenses waste disposal

facilities and collects user fees and excise taxes on in-region waste. Disposal of waste at undesignated facilities violates the Metro Code. Falsely claiming that waste originated outside the Metro boundary may violate criminal statutes. Violators can be charged with unpaid fees, fines up to \$500 per occurrence, and investigative costs. They may also be cited for theft by deception.
