BE KING FOR A DAY.

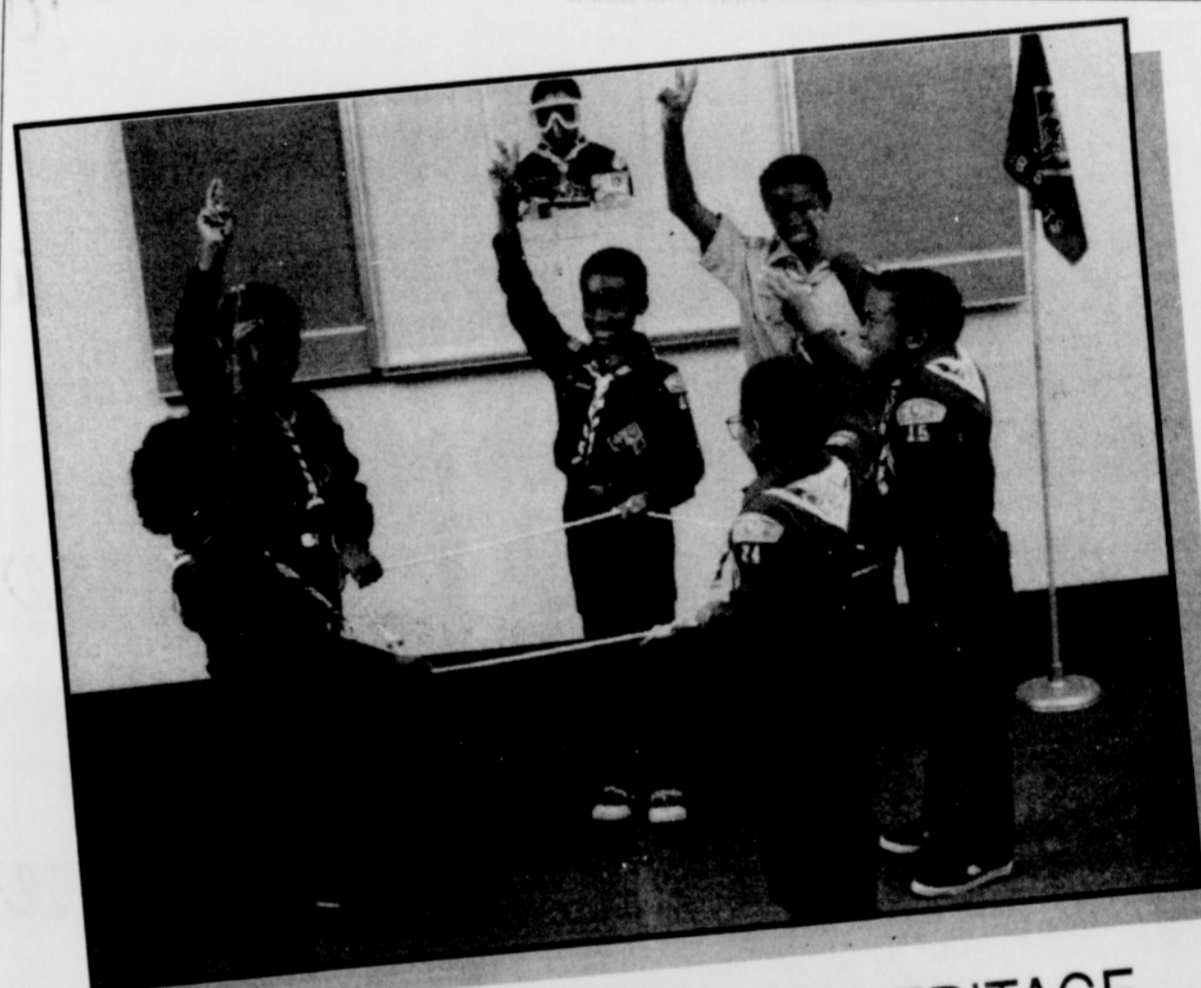
January 17 marks the observance of the national holiday honoring Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. What better way to celebrate his birthday than by living his dream?

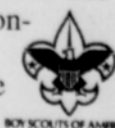
