Last week, I received a letter from a veteran in Nebraska asking what the Department of Veterans Affairs has been doing about the use of military personnel in radiation research. In looking for information, I found a release from the VA dated, ironically, December 7, 1994, the anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor in 1941, which gave an update on this subject.

According to VA Secretary Jesse Brown, the VA's Inspector General has joined the search for records on radioisotope nuclear medicine or radiation research that may have involved human subjects. Brown noted that, "Early in the search, we learned about the possible existence of a 'confidential' Atomic Medicine Division decades ago, but very little information has, so far, been uncovered." Brown has asked the Inspector General to use his office's audit expertise to help identify sources of documentation that can lead to more important information. ©1995 by King Features Synd.




