That means if they need a sturdy pair of boots to get a construction job, the caseworkers find them boots.

If they have children they can't leave, the case workers find them child care. If they need more job skills, the case workers find an appropriate training program.

To date, the project has placed 70 people back into jobs and another 31 into training programs, out of 519 households contacted.

According to the Portland Development Commission, the average cost per placement is \$843, compared to the thousands of dollars normally expended on creating one new job.
