## Martin L. King To Be Ordained Deacon

Martin L. King, will be ordained as a transitional deacon at Portland's Holy Redeemer Church on Saturday, May 27. The 5:30 p.m. Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop William J.

Mr. King was born April 28, 1954 in Lorian, Ohio. He was the third of four children born to Manson and Maria King. He began his education in the local public elementary school, but transferred into the Catholic elementary school in second grade. This led to his involvement as an altar boy at the parish. He and his family attended daily Mass. He graduated from Admiral King High School in Lorain, Ohio in 1973. After one year of college, he spent

several years working at a variety of jobs, and then joined the United States Air Force in 1981

While in the Air Force, Mr. King was involved with chapel activities such as teaching religious education classes and singing in the choir. He also continued his college studies. While in Korea, he met Father Bruce Brown of the Archdiocese of Portland, who encouraged his vocation. While still in the Air Force, he contacted the Archdiocese of Portland concerning study for the priesthood. He was accepted as a candidate for study in affiliation with the Archdiocese of Portland and the Archdiocese for Military Services. He entered Mount Angel Seminary in the fall,

1990. Martin received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Mount Angel in 1992.

His training in ministry has included placements at the MacLaren School for Boys, Woodburn, studying Spanish at Anglo-Americano, Puebla, Mexico, St. Mary Hispanic Ministry at Mt. Angel, Clinical Pastoral Education study at Loma Linda University, Loma Linda, CA. He was installed as a lector in January, 1993 and as an acolyte in January, 1994, both by Bishop Kenneth Steiner, Auxiliary Bishop of Portland. He was formally accepted into candidacy for priesthood by Archbishop Levada in October, 1994. He will spend this summer serving in the Archdiocese for Military Services.
