Strategies for coping with barriers to equal opportunity created by the assault on affirmative action will be the focus of Blacks In Government's (BiG) 17th Annual National Training, conference set for August 20-25, 1995 in St. Louis, MO at the Adams Marks Hotel, 4th and Chestnut Streets.

The theme of the conference is "Leadership, Excellence, Equity: Gateway to Tomorrow's Challenges."

Oscar Eason, Jr., President of the national organization, said the conference will focus on the effect of recent developments on equal op-

portunity. "The Supreme court decision against affirmative action, efforts to overturn affirmative action programs at the Congressional and state levels, combine to create a cloud over the future of those who are still seeking equal opportunity in the workplace. It calls for a greater understanding of the law and how to apply it to the kind of obstacles African American government workers encounter."

The session will include topics related to the future of affirmative action, career development in an era of reinventing government, new techniques for conflict resolution, cultur-

al rapport, the Republican/Democratic vision for Black America, and African American history from a Post-Reconstruction perspective.




