Lewis & Clark Candlelight Vigil Scheduled

Lewis & Clark College celebrates the legacy of Martin Luther King, Jr., Monday, Jan. 15, at 7 p.m. in the Council Chamber, Templeton Student Center, Lewis & Clark College, 0615 S. W. Palatine Hill Road.

The celebration features a video of King's speeches, including "I Have a Dream." A candlelight vigil will follow the video.

The event is free and open to the public.

King Dream Speech
Presented In Text

In celebration of the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., the Metropolitan Human Rights Commission will give a copy of the poster of Dr. King to anyone coming to the MHRC office at 1120 SW 5th, Room 516, Portland.

The poster contains the complete text of Dr. King's famous "I Have A Dream" speech.

The speech was given at the Lincoln Memorial on August 28, 1963 during the historic march on Washington and is most well-known and moving call for equality and justice.

The poster, one of a series that includes other human rights advocates such as Harvey Milk, Cesar Chavez and Abigail Scott Duniway, and the recently released United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights, normally sells for five dollars.

Well over a thousand of the posters have been distributed to schools, businesses and individuals.

MHRC is a City of Portland/Multnomah County agency whose mission is to foster mutual understanding and respect, and to protect the human rights of all persons in the City of Portland and Multnomah County regardless of socioeconomic status, religion, ethnicity, race, national origin, disability, age, gender, and sexual orientation.
