

In essence, co-carrier status means that MFS is afforded the same rights as the incumbent local exchange carriers, US West and GTE

This approval allows Oregon telephone customers to - for the first time - have a choice for their local telephone service, similar to the choice customers can now make when selecting a long distance telephone company.

MFS intends to begin working with the OPUC, US West and GTE to implement co-carrier arrangements, including interconnection of networks and reciprocal compensation.






