## Have a Heart Food Drive Helps Local Families

The Portland Police Bureau's Sunshine Division and United Grocers are currently gearing up for the fourth annual "Have a Heart Food Drive," the Sunshine Division's largest food drive of the year.

This week, the Oregonian will be distributing Have A Heart Food Drive grocery bags in the FOODday section.

People are encouraged to fill the bag with non-perishable items and bring them to any of the 62 Portland-area participating

United Grocers' retailers.

Participating United Grocers members include Thirftway Stores, Sentry supermarkets, Kienow's, Select markets, Food Outlet and many other independent retailers. Collections will be taken through Sunday, Feb. 11.

By donating canned goods and other non-perishables during the Have a Heart Food Drive, the Sunshine Division is able to assist needy families throughout the year.

The drive yielded over 183,600

pounds in food donations last year alone. This year's goal is to top that figure by 10 percent.

"Food donations are needed all year-long," explained Bob Tobin, program coordinator at the Sunshine Division.

"Thanksgiving and Christmas are busy times for donations, but in reality the need is still there throughout the year. The Have a Heart Food Drive enables us to provide year-round temporary emergency relief," Tobin said.

The Sunshine Division welcomes

all food donations for Have a Heart. Items that are currently the most needed include canned fruit, powdered milk, canned stew, canned tuna, elbow macaroni, pancake mix, instant potatoes, soap detergent, baby food (canned and dehydrated), canned meats, beans, rice, oatmeal, cereal, peanut butter, toiletries and diapers.

The Sunshine Division provides temporary emergency relief to needy Portland families by distributing food supplies and other necessities.

Approximately 400 food boxes are assembled every month.

Each food box contains basic non-perishables providing balanced meals. A family of four in need would receive a food box that would last three to four days.

United Grocers, Inc. is a retailer-owned cooperative serving more than 390 member stores throughout Oregon, Washington and northern California.

The company operates distribution centers in Portland, Medford and northern California.

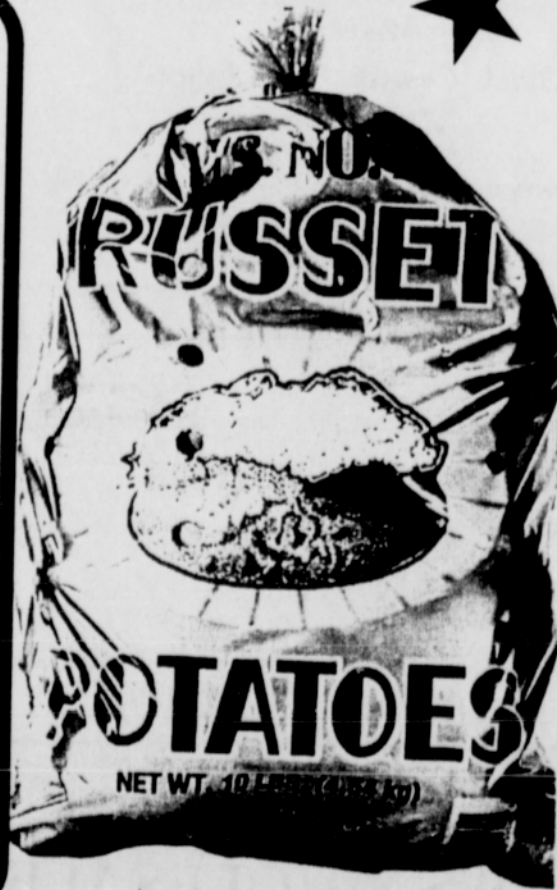
